MACMILLAN

Macmillan's ambition is to reach and improve the lives of everyone living with cancer and to inspire millions of others to do the same. Macmillan's research helps understand the needs, needs, numbers and experiences of people affected by cancer, to develop and influence better care and services.



LINGS AND NOTTS AIR AMBULANCE

The Lincs and Notts Air Ambulance Charitable Trust provides helicopter Emergency Medical Service covering 3,000 square miles. Flying at 154mph, the average journey time from an incident to the nearest hospital is 8 minutes.



MATTS FUND

Matthew Boulton from Welton was, in his final year of university, diagnosed with Malignant Melanoma. Referred by Lincoln County to Nottingham - Matt and his family realised there was no cure for this most serious form of Skin Cancer. Matt elected to raise funds for research and created Matt's Fund. Sadly at age 24 he died before his ambitions could be realised. Matt's Fund continues, and now raises awareness of skin cancer and Melanoma amongst young adults at school, college, and university and raises funds to support the work of cancer research unit at Nottingham University Hospitals Laboratory of Molecular Oncology, a leading centre in the development of immunotherapy drugs to treat Melanoma. Over 450 cases are diagnosed annually in Lincolnshire, if caught early it can be treated successfully but if left the disease is deadly so our byword is - "Some Moles are dangerous".

REFRESHMENTS

After your exertions in this year's Santa Fun Run refreshments might be needed. In addition to a wide range of high quality local pubs, cafes and restaurants free water will be provided to all runners and hot drinks will be available on the day in the Castle Square and at the Bailgate Methodist Church.

PARKING

Event parking is very limited. Please use city centre car parks. There is no parking in or around the Start in Union Road and the Finish area in Castle Square. Parking is also available in Pay and Display car parks around the city. The nearest parking area will probably be Westgate Car Park, opposite Westgate School. It is 'Pay & Display' and Disabled Blue Badger holders get double the allotted time (i.e. pay for 2 hours and you'll get 4 hours of parking).

PLEASE DO NOT PARK ON THE COURSE ROUTE. VEHICLES PARKED ON THE COURSE ROUTE BY THE 'NO WAITING' AREAS MAY BE REMOVED AT THE OWNER'S COST.

Please arrive in plenty of time. Roads on the route may be closed from 10am.

PARKING IN LINCOLN THIS CHRISTMAS

Lincoln's £30 million Transport Hub is currently being built. This major regeneration project is transforming our city centre by providing a state-of-the-art bus station, 1000 space multi-storey car park, retail space and a new pedestrian plaza.
