What's new for 2022?

- 1 Numbers this year are limited to 2000 places.
- We are continuing with the eco-registration which was so successful in 2021. Eco-registration does not include a santa suit but still includes a runner number and finisher's medal. This allows you to make or buy your own santa suit which can be re-used.



3. When you register for the 2022 event you will have the option of entering for 1 lap (2k) or 2 laps (4k). We have had to put prices up this year but only for the 2 lap option. We hope this keeps the event affordable for young families. Please ensure you select the option you want when registering.



- **4.** The course route has improved. We will start in Castle Square and end in Minster Yard.
- 5. We have a feature charity (EDAN Lincs) for 2022. Which will recieve 50% of funds raised.







The route for 18 December 2022

Our featured charity



Charities are always welcome to join us in the Lincoln Santa Fun Run. This year we are appointing a Featured Charity for the event. They will recieve 50% of the funds we raise from the event. The remaining 50% of funds raised will be distributed to other local and national charities as in previous years.

Our Featured Charity for the 2022 Lincoln Santa Fun Run is EDAN Lincs (Ending Domestic Abuse in Lincolnshire).

EDAN LINCS (Ending Domestic Abuse Now in Lincolnshire) is a registered charity (charity number 1092913) that provides holistic support and assistance to men, women and children suffering or fleeing from domestic abuse and those who have been affected by domestic abuse it in the past. We recognise that men and women are not always ready to leave abusive relationships permanently, but may want to access support to discuss their situation and explore options available to them. The services provided are free, confidential and ultimately are service user led.

EDAN Lincs began in 1999 and got Charity status in 2001, our head office is in Lincoln, and we operate across the county of Lincolnshire. Their mission statement is To support and empower all those affected by domestic abuse. To raise awareness of the impacts of domestic abuse and promote intolerance of it

EDAN Lincs has three areas of service.

Refuge

EDAN Lincs provides safe, emergency, temporary accommodation to any man or woman – with or without children – who are fleeing domestic abuse.

Outreach Service

Our Outreach Specialist Domestic Abuse workers provide advice, safety planning, support and signposting to individuals and families in these areas who experience domestic abuse and to help them to live free from violence, thus influencing positively upon their safety, emotional well-being, health education and enjoyment of life.

Part of this service is intervention offered by the Child Young Persons (CYP) workers team, who work with children and young people and their non-abusive parent in a family focused way and/or on a 1:1 basis over structured sessions in and around the effects and impact on living or experiencing domestic abuse.

IDVA Service

EDAN Lincs is also the provider for Lincolnshire Independent Domestic Violence Advisor Service (IDVA's) who provide a specialist service for males, females aged 16, and over, who have been referred into a Multi-Agency Risk Assessment Conference (MARAC) and have been assessed as high risk for short-term intervention.
