Cut off deadlines for ordering places and collecting suits & numbers

As Sunday 17th December fast approaches we have the following deadlines for anyone still requiring tickets or collection of santa suits or runner numbers

Sunday 10th December 5.00 pm	Postal delivery option ends - collection only on any further orders
Friday 15th December 12:00 midday	Collection from any of the three pick up points ends. Further collections are only available from our Marquee in Castle Square on Sunday 17th December between 09.30 am and 10.30 am
Saturday 16th December 5.00 pm	Online selling of tickets closes at 5.00 pm Saturday 16th
Sunday 17th December 9.30 am to 10:30 am	Our Marquee in Castle Square will be open to provide 1. Any remaining suit and number collections (bring your confirmation email) 2. Subject to availability late entries can be purchased (card & contactless payments only)

Once you receive your own runner number scan the QR code printed at bottom of the number to register your personal details before Sunday 17th December.

This also means you will receive a personalised (digital) certificate of participation after the event.

You can, optionally, also provide any important personal information which may be required in the event of an emergency. This information is treated in confidence.

On the Day - Arriving


The event starts at 11:00 am in Castle Square which will be very busy so please aim to arrive by no later than 10:30 am. There will be parking restrictions and road closures from 10.30 am and so make allowances accordingly. Many of the local car parks will not be accessible after 10:30 am. In Castle Square we will have a Food Bank Donation Point (for the Lincolnshire Community Larder). We are asking every entrant to bring just one item to donate - a little from many will make a big difference. Thankyou



On the Day - The Start

The run will be started in Castle Square at 11:00 am by the The Right Worshipful the Mayor of the City of Lincoln. There will be up to 2000 santas (plus friends and family) there so it will be very busy. Captain Hook and Tinkerbell (from this year's Drill Hall Pantomine) will also be there to cheer you all on. If your team would like a commentator shoutout send us a message beforehand through the website. Local press and media (radio and TV) will also be present.







On the Day - The Run

There are stewards and volunteers on the route to guide and cheer you. Please follow any instructions given.

Please do not use headphones when running we need you to hear any instructions and announcements and we want you to enjoy the atmosphere. By the Lincoln Hotel you will see the signs directing you to the finish for the 1 lap route or along Eastgate for the 2nd lap

The run finishes in Minster Yard (by Lincoln Catheral). WELL DONE!


