Getting Ready

Weather

The one thing we have no control over of course is our December weather. We will be monitoring the weather forcast frequently up until the Sunday morning. Your safety is of paramount concern. If weather conditions require us to make any changes we will publish this on our website, our social media outlets (eg Facebook) and through local

outlets (eg Facebook) and through local press and media (eg radio).

Please check our website the day before. We have added a weather check link to help you too.

Travel

It will be busy and there are road closures in place so check your travel and parking plans to ensure you arrive in good time.

Remember to Bring

- 1. Your Runner Number no number no entry and no medal
- 2. Safety pins to attach your runner number
- 3. Your Santa Suit
- 4. A small contribution to the Food Bank (please)
- 5. If you are bringing a dog dog poo disposal bags

Register

Each participant must register their details online (use the QR code on your runner number) before the event starts. It is your responsibility to ensure you are fit and well enough to take part. We advise you to consider not attending if you are unwell.

Dress Code & Behaviour

If you are providing your own costume it needs to reflect the nature of the event and preferably in Santa Red (although the odd elf is welcome).

Your runner number should be worn and displayed on the front of your body.

No number = no entry and no medal.

Any other banner eg "In memory of ..", "I'm running for ..." etc should be worn on your back

This is a community and family festive fun run. It is not an opportunity to promote views, however worthy, of any political, religious or other cause. Flags of any kind are not permitted.

Any behaviour, costume or prop considered offensive or a safety risk to the runner or others will not be permitted

Arriving

The event starts at 11:00 am in Castle Square which will be very busy so please aim to arrive by no later than 10:30 am

Parking restrictions are in force. There will be road closures from 10.30 am and so make allowances accordingly. Local car parks on the affected roads will not be accessible after 10:30 am.



There are limited public toilets in the area including one in Castle Square.

Food and beverages (other than complimentary water and snacks at the finish) are not available as part of the event. There are a number of food and beverage outlets nearby eg on Bailgate and we encourage you to make use of these and support our local traders.

We do not have facilities to hold baggage and other personal belongings, sorry.

Dogs are not allowed in the grounds of Lincoln Castle

Once again we are supporting a **FoodBank Donation Point** on the day in Castle Square. We are asking every participant and spectator to bring along one item for the foodbank. This winter will be a challenge for so many families, any help you can give will be appreciated.

This year's foodbank donations will go to the Lincolnshire Community Larder. Please note this will be for food donations not money. Foods should be non-perishable, in date and unopened. You can see what's most in need on their website:

Street Collections

The event takes place in a public place. Street collections can only be carried out if a licence from Lincoln City Council has first been obtained. This is a legal requirement.

The Start

The run will be started in Castle Square at 11:00 am by the The Right Worshipful the Mayor of the City of Lincoln. There will be up to 2000 santas (plus friends and family) there so it will be very busy. Captain Hook and Tinkerbell (from this year's Drill Hall Pantomine) will also be there to cheer you all on.

As in previous years the local press and media (radio and TV) will be present

If your team would like a commentator shoutout send us a message beforehand through the website.

If you have registered to bring your dog remember

- (i) it MUST be kept on a SHORT lead at ALL times. (No long leads, bungee leads, recoil leads)
- (ii) you MUST clean up any mess (bring your own poo bags!)
- (iii) dogs are not allowed in the grounds of Lincoln Castle

The Run & Walk

There are stewards and volunteers on the route to guide and cheer you. Please follow any instructions given.

Please do not use headphones when running we need you to hear any instructions and announcements and we want you to enjoy the atmosphere.



Look out for signs by the Lincoln Hotel directing you straight on to the finish for the 1 lap route or to turn right along Eastgate for the 2nd lap.

First aid and urgent medical services are provided by St John Ambulance who will be based at the finish area in Minster Yard with mobile teams on the route, If you need medical help please contact one of the St John Ambulance first aiders, event stewards, or volunteer marshalls around the route.

Be safe and considerate to others as there are all ages and abilities taking part.
